Areas of Competition:

Judge's Tea (70%) - The private interview is an opportunity for the contestant to represent herself as an individual and show her personality. Attire is business casual / Sunday's best - think what the modern woman would wear to a job interview.

Contest Performance (30%) - The on-stage speech is a chance for the judges to see how you respond, as well as an opportunity for the contestant to display her personality to the audience. On-stage speech will be discussed further in practices and will come from the question, "Why do you want to be Medina County Fair Queen?" This should be a 1-3 minute speech.
